Dear Secondary Students and Parents,

Our school’s mission is to “inspire students to impact the world for Jesus Christ...” Based upon this, we are requiring four hours of Christian service from each of our secondary students (grades 7-12) each quarter. This works out to be approximately thirty minutes a week. This time can be completed all at once or in shorter increments. Students will keep a record of their hours served (signed by their supervisor) and upon completion of their hours will be evaluated by their supervisor. Similarly to the summer book report, hours completed during the summer may count for one quarter of your choice.

Students are responsible for arranging their own service projects. Christian service is to be free of compensation (financial or otherwise). For our purposes the service must have a sacrifice value to it. Christian service is to benefit others in need, and should not be family members or friends, nor should a family member be the project supervisor. Each Christian service will be graded, and will be weighted as a test grade each quarter.

A list of possible volunteer opportunities that may be used for Christian service is attached. Other opportunities will be permitted, but must be pre-approved by your Bible teacher. If you have any questions, please contact your Bible teacher.
